About

Vilnius University – the first and largest university in Lithuania, one of the oldest and most prominent higher education institutions in Central and Eastern Europe, established in 1579 in Lithuania's capital city Vilnius, with a faculty in the second largest city, Kaunas.



History

In 1579, King Stephen Bathory's charter transformed the Jesuit college, founded in 1570, into an establishment of higher education, Academia et Universitas Vilnensis Societatis Jesu, the transformation being confirmed by Pope Gregory XIII.

Since then university has various periods. During more than four centuries of its existence, the University of Vilnius has seen periods of growth and decline, revival, and closure.

In 1832 University was closed down according to the orders of tsar Nicholas I, and it was not reopened until 1919. From 1919, due to the complicated political situation in Lithuania, the management and the name of the university were changed numerous times.

After Lithuania declared independence, in 1990 The University got back its autonomy, regained Vilnius University name, and adopted its statute.
